Test conditions

Prior to testing the samples were subjected to one wash cycle in accordance with EN ISO 6330:2012 programme 4M (a gentle wash at 40°C), followed by line drying.

Following drying the samples were placed in a conditioned laboratory with an environment maintained at 20±2°C and 65±5% relative humidity. Testing was started within 5 minutes of removal from the conditioned environment.

CANCELLATION AND RETURNS

Cancellation of orders for goods, services, training or consultancy is only acceptable by prior agreement of SATRA and a charge will normally be made.

5. **CLAIMS**

Claims for errors, shortages etc should be notified within 10 days of date of receipt. In the event of goods damaged in transit, packing materials should be retained for examination; otherwise no liability can be accepted.

Payment terms are net 21 days from date of invoice. Failure to comply with the terms of payment may result in delayed delivery of goods and services and a review of the Customer's credit account.
